

Privacy Notice

AER takes privacy and the protection of personal data very seriously. It is very important that users have trust in the AER website. AER therefore commits itself to treat personal data confidentially.

Introduction

This Privacy Notice is designed to inform you about the personal data relating to you which The Association of European Radios, a European Economic Interest Grouping (EEIG) and hereinafter referred as "The Association of European Radios, AER, It, Its", collects via the website www.aereurope.org (referred to hereinafter as the "Website"), why AER collects and processes such personal data, on which legal basis, and how AER will handle personal data you provide AER with and personal data AER learns about you from your visit to the Website. Your use of the Website implies your acknowledgment of this Privacy Notice.

Legal basis

AER processes your personal data on the basis of Its legitimate interest when you fill in the form to register to AER's annual conference or to any other event organised by AER.

For the other purposes described below AER processes your personal data on the basis of your specific consent.

You have the right to withdraw such consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of such processing before the withdrawal of consent.

Personal data collected

AER collects personal data relating to you (referred to hereinafter as "Personal Data") in two ways:

- through registration and sending of information that you choose to enter on certain pages of the Website. The information marked with the "*" symbol must be provided, in order to enable It to fulfil the processing purposes, as mentioned below. Such Personal Data directly collected from you include your first and last name, personal or professional email address, personal or professional mobile or other phone number, title, Company name, Company information, message, you have chosen to register or other personal information or contact information you provide It with. AER may also ask for your comments, suggestions, or other information relating to the Website, Its services, or Its organisation. Other specific types of information may be requested in connection with surveys AER could invite you to participate.
- For the purpose of sending you the AER Bulletin/Newsletter

Use of Personal Data

Your Personal Data will exclusively be used to the extent necessary to allow AER:

- to respond to your direct request, as described at the time when AER collects your Personal Data or as otherwise described to you prior to the use of your Personal Data
- to send you event information

AER does not use your Personal Data for other purposes. Prior to using Personal Data for other purposes, AER will inform you about such change to this Privacy Notice. In case of consent-based activities, AER will not process your Personal Data for such new purposes without first obtaining your consent.

Special category of personal data

AER will not collect or process any special category of personal data relating to you. The special categories of Personal Data include data revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs or other beliefs of a similar nature, trade union membership, genetic data, biometric data for the purpose of uniquely identifying a natural person, health, sex life or sexual orientation.

Sharing Personal Data

AER will not make your Personal Data available to any third party and shall not publicly disclose the Personal Data unless such transfers are based on your specific consent, necessary for the performance of a contract entered into between you and AER, or when such transfer of Personal Data is otherwise authorised or compulsory by law or by order of an administration or judicial authority.

Use of cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or other device by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the website.

General information about the cookies used

This Website uses cookies to improve your experience on the website, to analyse your use of the Website via Jetpack and to enable social interaction features with supported external social networking websites.

When you visit the AER Website, cookies will collect the name of the internet provider, the IP address of the user, the website that has referred the user to the AER Wevsite, data and time. This data is collected anonymously and exclusively for statistical usage.

When you visit our Website for the first time, the entry page will show information on privacy and respective wording regarding the use of cookies through a "cookie banner". If you continue to actively use the Website and do not actively object to the use of cookies, you agree to our use of cookies and such agreement will be stored in your browser, so that the information does not have to be repeated on every page of the Website. Should the consent be missing in your browser (e.g. if you deleted your cookies), the "cookie banner" with privacy information will appear again the next time you visit the Website.

AER may install and use certain technically required cookies which therefore do not require your prior consent. AER may also use session cookies which are automatically deleted at the end of your session and which also do not require your prior consent. Other cookies (such as cookies to improve the navigational experience by keeping record of certain data – this avoids you having to reintroduce such data at each connection – and by tailoring the content of the Website to your preferences) may be installed and used on the basis of your consent. You will find all relevant information about the cookies used by this Website in the table below. The Legal basis of this provision is enshrined in Article 6 1 (f) of the General Data Protection Regulation.

Share on social networks
